1983 - A devastating fire consumes the Washington Street Baptist Church Educational Building. Undaunted, the school family re-establishes classes in less than a week and the first elementary classroom building is built at the school's current location.

1985 - The first senior class graduates from Greenville Christian School and the longstanding tradition of a senior trip to Washington D.C. begins.

### 1986-1995 A Decade of Growth

1986 - The school's gymnasium is built and athletic programs become an integral part of student life.

1988 - GCS receives formal accreditation from the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI).

1989 - A National Honor Society chapter is established on campus and the surrounding athletic fields are developed.

1993 - An annex building providing more classroom space and a new library are constructed next to the GCS Elementary School building.

### 1996- 2005 A Decade of Blessings

1997 - Student service to the community begins with the Service Learning Projects program.

2004 - The school's missions program, called "Be My Witnesses", adds an annual mission trip to an orphanage in Mexico and is awarded Exemplary Status by ACSI.

2005 - The Greenville Christian School Foundation is established to build an endowment to support the mission of the school.

In 2006, Greenville Christian School celebrated its 30th anniversary with a heart full of gratitude for God's faithfulness. To date, GCS graduates have received over \$100,000 in scholarships and have continued their education at a variety of schools, such as The Naval Academy, Abilene Christian University, Duke, Biola, Vanderbilt, Austin College, The University of Texas, Ouachita Baptist University, Texas A&M, Texas Tech, Baylor, and Oklahoma Baptist University.
