

Eagle Tickets – Tuition Credit Program

For any new family that a current Eagle Nation family refers, they will get a financial credit on their tuition for each new* student who applies and is accepted for enrollment. (*new – has not attended GCS for at least one year.)

Eagle Ticket Promotion: March 1, 2015 – January 4, 2016 for new enrollments.

Meet GCS and Tour Dates: March 28th and 29th, 2:00 pm

Eagle Ticket Tuition Credits: School Year 2015-2016

How the Eagle Ticket Works:

- **You invite prospective families**
 - You offer families an invitation to visit the school.
 - The best opportunity for families to visit will be to attend a Meet GCS event.
- **They visit the school**
 - They can attend a Meet GCS event with a group, OR
 - They can schedule a personal tour of the school.
- **We inform them**
 - At Meet GCS, prospective families will have the opportunity to learn statistics, hear from Mr. Bowers, an alumnus or student and a parent, see a video of “school life” and take a guided tour of the school. A school representative will be available to sit with them afterwards and answer any further questions they may have about enrollment.
 - For personal tours, Mr. Bowers or another school representative will walk the school with them and talk about the GCS experience.
- **We follow up with them (if needed)**
 - The families often have additional questions. We like to let them know that we will answer any additional detailed questions they may have.
 - Your feedback about their experience with meeting the school is also very helpful to us in our presentations
- **They begin the application process and they indicate you as the referring family**
 - If they decide to apply, **GIVE THEM YOUR EAGLE TICKET with YOUR family’s name for them to turn in with their application.** Only one eagle ticket referral per new family.
 - Upon application, they will turn in YOUR Eagle Ticket with YOUR family’s name.
 - Testing (for K-12) and a family interview will take place.
- **Upon acceptance and enrollment**, the ONE Eagle Ticket THEY TURNED IN with your name will be applied as a credit to your tuition based on the number of new students that family enrolled.
 - Only one family can receive credit for the newly enrolling family.

- The Eagle Ticket will be credited monthly to your child's tuition account over 10 months, beginning with the August payment. Credit will be pro-rated for any student enrolling and starting after the beginning of the school year until January 4th.
- A family's tuition account must remain current and be in good standing as documented by the Accounting office to receive the Eagle Ticket Credit.
- If the new student withdraws or is asked to leave, the incentive payout ends the same month as the withdrawal.

GC Enrollment Requirements:

We are anxious to enroll students whose parents will partner with us in accomplishing our mission and our vision.

Mission:

- **The mission of Greenville Christian School is to equip children of Christians with excellent academics, Biblical life applications and leadership skills so they are prepared to excel through their lives.**

Vision:

- It is our prayer and intent students and alumni of GCS succeed in their personal and professional Christ-centered lives and they influence the world through their knowledge, service, talents and resources.

As a reminder, Greenville Christian School is the Christian families' trusted source for an excellent education, so the following are some of the enrollment requirements: (see the Parent/Student handbook for a complete list.)

Family requirements:

- At least one parent acknowledges a genuine relationship with Jesus Christ through the process of a family interview and agrees to the Statement of Faith as it applies to teaching a Biblical worldview.
- Parent(s) or guardian(s) must have legal custody and the student and the parent/guardian must reside in the same household the majority of the time.
- If there are two parents residing in the household, they must be a legally married man and woman.
- The family attends a local Christian church.

Student requirements:

- Prospective students will be tested for grade level ability and data gathered in the interview.
- Students with learning differences or physical disabilities will be considered on a case-by-case basis and evaluated according to the school's ability to meet their needs adequately.
- Students must be alcohol and drug-free.
- Students will not be admitted* if:
 - They have been expelled from a previous school.
 - They have a court record.
 - They are married, have been previously married, are parents, or who are questioning gender identity issues or homosexual lifestyle choices.
 - They promote a non-Christian environment at the school.
 - *Legitimate exceptions will be considered on an individual basis by the Admissions Committee and the Board prior to enrollment.
