# A note from the Head of School

Greenville Christian School's name states that it is a school, but it is a particular kind of school. It is a school defined by our common interest and our commitment to furthering the Kingdom of God. Our common interest defines who we are, and it is a commitment we make to God and our families. Our commitment is identified by the psalmist in Psalm 78 5-8:

He decreed statutes for Jacob and established the law in Israel, which He commanded our ancestors to teach their children, so the next generation would know them,

even the children yet to be born,

- and they in turn would tell their children. Then they would put their trust in God
  - and would not forget His deeds but would keep His commands.
